Ireland at the FIP General Assembly in Doha 2024

The Padel Federation of Ireland proudly represented Ireland at the FIP General Assembly in Doha, held during the 2024 FIP World Padel Championships. This gathering brought together the affiliated national federations who represent the ever-growing community of padel players around the world.

The **34th FIP General Assembly** saw the unanimous re-election of Luigi Carraro as President of FIP. Padel is currently played in 150 countries and has **87 affiliated member federations**. There are an estimated **30 million** players worldwide. The sport features two major world circuits: **Premier Padel** and the **FIP CUPRA Tour.** A key objective is to have padel included in the Brisbane Olympics in 2032.

National Team Recruitment

While in Doha, the PFI launched its National Padel Team registration for 2025, inviting players across Juniors, Absolutes, and Veterans categories to compete for Ireland in 2025. We are currently requesting that players register their interest and we will announce trials and key dates in the near future. Please ask your Club Rep for more details!







PADEL EUROPE

During the FIP European Padel Championships, representatives from 31 countries came together to establish 'Padel Europe,' a new continental entity aimed at further strengthening our sport both on a continental and global scale. Ireland is proud to be a founding member, and we will continue to collaborate closely with our fellow member federations to advance and develop padel in emerging padel nations.









Ireland at the 2024 FIP Senior World Padel Championships

Ireland celebrated a historic moment in April 2024 by competing at the FIP Senior World Padel Championships in Alicante, Spain.

This was the first time in history that Ireland competed at World level in the main draw of a padel world championships. Our team, comprising of 38 players and 3 coaches, participated across multiple age categories (+35 to +55) and demonstrated a resilience and sportsmanship that we aim to instill in our juniors.

The PFI team efforts at the World Championships, supported by Cupra Ireland, underscores the sport's rapid development in Ireland. This milestone reflects Ireland's increasing presence on the international padel stage and its commitment to fostering the sport.

Dates for the 2025 FIP Senior European Championships will be released shortly and we invite all players and clubs to sign up. Please see details below. Clubs are welcome to host national trials and/or training events.







IRISH PADEL TOUR



2024 saw an incredible increase in the number of clubs, locations and players participating and hosting the **National Ranking tournament** around Ireland. Almost 200 players participated in the **All-Ireland Championships in September**, during which the **PFI AGM also took place**.







New features 2025

This year, we are delighted to announce that the Irish Padel Tour introduces a new format with **10 Challengers**, **4 Majors**, **and a Final Master**, which will be the most exclusive national event where the top-ranked players will compete to crown the season's champions. The Majors will offer higher ranking points and bigger prizes compared to the Challengers.

Additionally, this year we are launching a **new website and mobile app**, where players can register for tournaments, check the ranking, view live match results, and stay updated with all tour information.

With these updates, the Irish Padel Tour promises to be much **more exciting and dynamic**, offering an enhanced experience for both players and fans. We look forward to announcing exciting new sponsors for the tour!





Rockwell National Junior Padel Development Programme

Coaching-the-Coaches





In order to progress as a padel playing nation we need to **develop our juniors**, and in order to this effectively we need to learn from, and work with, the experts.

After months of collaboration with the **FIP Development team**, we designed a pilot programme aimed at developing junior players in emerging padel countries. We welcomed the experts over from Spain to commence the training to get our Rockwell National Junior Development programme off to the very best start.

20 coaches from around Ireland joined us over a weekend in July for the initial stage of the programme. These coaches will continue to receive mentorship as they help role out the programme Nationwide.

Nominated by the Spanish Federation (FEP), **PadeICV** work with, and mentor, our coaches to help design and deliver the best **Junior National Development programme** for Ireland. PadeICV has worked with juniors and trained the best players in Spain over the past 25+ years, we are delighted to have them on board to work with the PFI and provide our coaches with the best training.

FISU grants official recognition to FIP



The International University Sports Federation (FISU) is pleased to announce the official recognition of Padel as a FISU-recognised sport, marking a significant step in the expansion of university sports worldwide. This recognition follows a comprehensive evaluation of the International Padel Federation's (FIP) submission, which demonstrated the sport's rapid growth, global appeal, and alignment with FISU's mission of fostering innovation, inclusivity, and excellence in university sports.

"This recognition underscores FISU's commitment to embracing emerging sports that align with our vision", said Matthias Remund, FISU Secretary General/CEO. "Padel's dynamic and inclusive nature makes it an ideal addition to the FISU ecosystem, providing new opportunities for student-athletes to compete and develop on an international stage".

The recognition of Padel within FISU paves the way for enhanced collaboration between FISU and FIP. As a next step, both organisations will work towards formalising their cooperation through a memorandum of understanding, which will outline joint initiatives and development opportunities for university Padel competitions.

"This is an extraordinary achievement for FIP and all those who love padel", said Luigi Carraro, the President of the International Padel Federation (FIP). "This recognition reflects our commitment, and that of our National Federations, towards younger generations in terms of sporting results, both at competitive and amateur level, as well as fundamental principles such as inclusion, socialisation and cultural exchange. Working with FISU by featuring padel in the university competitions will be a primary goal and a specific effort that FIP and its member federations will make with great enthusiasm and passion".

FISU looks forward to fostering the growth of Padel within university sports and working closely with FIP to further integrate the sport into the international university sports movement.





Women and Girls in Sport Initiative

This was developed in 2022 as an initiative designed to encourage women and girls to engage in competitive padel. All clubs around Ireland are invited to sign up to this initiative rolling out in 2025!

Our **Activities** include **PFI funded courses** held in **Moira, Dublin and Cavan** and the initiative has already successfully delivered players competing at the European level.

This initiative will continue into 2025, targeting greater participation and success stories. We also aim to address and target the **younger teen player** cohort who traditionally hit a drop out from organised sport. Disability Inclusion Programmes



We introduced the embedding of the Disability Inclusion module into the PFI certification course. This means that all PFI recognised coaches will be required to complete this module in order to be a certified padel coach. Funded by the PFI, this course was held a number of times throughout 2024.

We continue to Collaborate with Active Disability and Eimear Breathnach, President of Paralympics Ireland, to deliver these essential and comprehensive workshops, available to all clubs and coaches.

International Collaboration

The hugely successful programme, developed by the PFI and funded by Erasmus Plus, collaborated with the Spanish Padel Federation (FEP) to offer paid internships to Irish padel coaches and staff in Spain.

This unique opportunity provided hands-on experience and knowledge transfer from leading padel experts. We were delighted to send eight members of our team, from clubs around Ireland, to travel during 2024 around Spain.

This programme has strengthened the skills and expertise of our Irish padel professionals, aiming to enhance the quality of the sport across the country. FIP COURSES



Clean Sport Education

This course, delivered by the International Padel Federation (FIP), highlights its commitment to promoting fair play and sporting integrity. The webinar covered essential topics such as anti-doping policies, the safe use of medications, the health risks of doping, and the importance of ensuring transparency in sports.

The Padel Federation of Ireland (PFI) supported this initiative, reinforcing its dedication to fostering a clean, ethical, and fair environment for all athletes. The recording of the webinar will be sent to players who missed the webinar.

FIP Referee Course

The International Padel Federation (FIP) has launched the International Padel Referee Level 1 Course to standardise refereeing globally and support the sport's growth. The course combines online classes, practical training, and covers FIP rules and regulations, with successful participants earning a diploma to officiate internationally. The Padel Federation of Ireland (PFI) supports this initiative to elevate Irish refereeing standards and strengthen Ireland's role in the global padel community. Some of our experienced PFI coaches have now successfully completed the certified course and are joining the community of internationally accredited Padel Referees. Clubs and coaches can nominate applicants through the PFI for participation in the FIP courses.

This year, the Padel Federation of Ireland is set to deliver an exciting range of initiatives aimed at furthering the growth of padel across Ireland.



FIP Euro Padel Cup

Ireland will start getting ready for the European Padel Championships now called the **FIP Euro Padel Cup!**

With **40 European countries** taking part, the dates have just been confirmed for **July 7th -13th!** Location is still TBC.

We are thrilled to confirm that there is a **new formula** specifically designed to ensure equal, fair and exciting competition.



A NEW FORMULA

To achieve these objectives, competitions are divided into 3 parts:

Phase 1: 24 European Teams. This is the qualifying phase open to all National Teams not participating in the Phase 2 and Final 8. Teams will be grouped based on the number of entries, and the format will be designed to ensure equal, fair and exciting competition.

Phase 2: This stage will include the 12 Teams ranked 5th to 16th plus 4 Teams from Phase 1. They will be divided into 4 groups of 4, with the best Team from each group advancing to FINAL 8.

FINAL 8: This is the top-tier competition, featuring the 4 highest-ranked teams with direct qualification, plus 4 teams advancing from Phase 2.
