What Are Cookies?

A cookie is a small text file placed on your device when you visit our website. Cookies help our website remember your actions and preferences over time, so you don't have to re-enter them each visit.

How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to make our website work properly, to understand how visitors use it, and - where you consent - to support our marketing activity.

The Cookies We Use

- **Necessary Cookies:** required for the website to function (e.g. navigation, security). These cannot be switched off.
- **Preference Cookies:** remember settings such as region or display preferences.
- **Statistic (Analytics) Cookies:** help us understand how visitors interact with our site, via Google Analytics and Google Tag Manager.
- **Marketing Cookies:** used to deliver and measure relevant advertising, including via TikTok and Meta (Facebook/Instagram).

Consent

When you first visit our website, you will be shown a cookie banner powered by Cookiebot. You can accept, reject, or customise which categories of cookie you allow. You can change your preferences at any time by clicking the Cookiebot icon or link in our website footer.

Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies are set by trusted third parties when you visit our site, including Google Analytics, Google Tag Manager, and our advertising partners (TikTok, Meta). Each third party has its own privacy and cookie notices, which we encourage you to review.

How and Why We Use Your Personal Data

We only process personal data where we have a lawful basis to do so:

- Performance of a contract — e.g. providing financial advice or wealth management services you have engaged us for
- Legal obligation — e.g. Central Bank of Ireland and anti-money laundering (AML) requirements, including identity verification and record-keeping
- Legitimate interests — e.g. responding to enquiries, improving our website and services, and communicating with existing clients about relevant services
- Consent — e.g. sensitive/health data, and marketing communications where consent is the applicable basis

How We Share Your Data

We share personal data with trusted categories of third party where necessary to provide our services, including:

- Product providers (pension, investment and insurance providers we work with as a multi-agency intermediary)
- IT, cloud hosting and software providers
- Professional advisers (e.g. our own lawyers, accountants and auditors)
- Analytics and advertising providers (see below)

We may use Stripe for payment processing purposes, where applicable to our services.

We may embed third-party media on our website, such as Soundcloud, for audio content.

Fraud Prevention and Law Enforcement

As part of fraud monitoring and prevention, we may be legally required to share your personal data with government bodies and law enforcement. These bodies may retain a record of the information we provide to them for this purpose.

Sale or Merger

We may share your personal information as part of a merger or acquisition. If Rockwell is involved in a merger, financing, transaction or proceeding involving sale, transfer, divestiture, or disclosure of all or a portion of our business or assets, or in the event of a liquidation, insolvency, bankruptcy, or receivership, we may share your information with that company before and after the transaction closes. Unless otherwise directed by applicable law, your information would remain subject to the terms of the applicable privacy policy in effect at the time of transfer, and you will be notified of any such changes in advance.

Marketing Preferences

We may send you direct marketing communications, product information and promotional offers where you have consented, where we have an existing business relationship and can rely on legitimate interest, or where the law of your country otherwise permits.

You will always have full control of your marketing preferences. If you do not wish to continue receiving marketing information from us:

- Unsubscribe using the link included in any marketing communication from us; or
- Withdraw your consent at any time by emailing info@rockwellfinancial.ie

Customers in the EEA and UK also have the right to object to their data being processed for direct marketing at any time, by contacting us at the same address. We aim to process all such requests promptly, though it may take a few days to fully implement an opt-out across our systems.

Our Use of Analytics

We use Google Analytics and Google Tag Manager to understand how visitors use our website, so that we can improve it. This processing relies on your consent (via the cookie banner) or, for essential measurement, our legitimate interests.

Our Use of Targeted Advertising

We advertise our services using the following platforms:

- TikTok
- Google Analytics / Google Ads
- Meta (Facebook and Instagram)

These tools may use pseudonymised data (such as a hashed email address) to help deliver relevant advertising and to measure its effectiveness. You can opt out at any time by contacting info@rockwellfinancial.ie or via the relevant platform's own privacy controls.

Links to Other Websites and Third Parties

Our website may include links to social media platforms and other websites. If you follow a link to any of these platforms or websites, their own privacy policies will apply, and we do not accept responsibility or liability for those policies. Please check them before submitting any personal data.

Securing Your Data

Communication between your browser and our website uses a secure encrypted connection wherever your personal data is involved. We have put in place physical, electronic and managerial security procedures to protect your personal data against accidental loss, destruction or damage.

Any data transmission over the internet can never be guaranteed fully secure, and provision of personal data to us is at your own risk - however, we take all reasonable measures to protect it with appropriate technical and operational security. Where we disclose your data to trusted third parties, we require them to have appropriate security measures in place and work with them to ensure your data privacy rights are respected.

In the event of a personal data breach, we will notify you and any applicable data protection authority where we are legally required to do so.

Members Portal

Our client Members Portal (accessible via 'Members Login') is a separate, secure platform used by existing clients to view their financial information. Personal data processed through the Members Portal is covered by a separate Privacy Notice specific to that platform, available on request or within the portal itself.

Retaining Your Data

We do not keep personal data for longer than necessary. As a firm regulated by the Central Bank of Ireland:

- Client records are generally retained for 6 years after the end of our relationship with you, in line with the Consumer Protection Code
- Anti-money laundering (AML) records are retained for a minimum of 5 years, as required by the Criminal Justice (Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing) Act

Where we are legally required to retain data, we cannot action an early erasure request for that data — see 'Your Rights' below.

Transferring Your Data Outside the EEA

Where your personal data is transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA), we ensure this is done on the basis of an EU adequacy decision, or by using Standard Contractual Clauses approved under the GDPR. Contact us for further information on international transfers.

Your Rights

Subject to certain conditions, you have the right to:

- Be informed about how your data is processed
- Access the personal data we hold about you
- Have inaccurate data corrected, or incomplete data completed
- Request erasure of your data, where we do not have a legal obligation to retain it
- Request restriction of, or object to, certain processing
- Request portability of data you have provided to us
- Withdraw consent at any time, where consent is our legal basis for processing
- Complain to the Data Protection Commission (www.dataprotection.ie) if you are unhappy with how we handle your data
